1. Call to Order

Deputy Mayor Pennings called the meeting to order at 8:00 am.

2. Approval of Agenda

The Committee approved the agenda for the June 20th meeting.

3. Approval of the May 9th Minutes

The Committee approved the minutes as drafted from the February May 9th, 2024

4. Development and Infrastructure Updates

- a. Shedden and Fingal Wastewater Servicing Updates
 Director VanOorspronk provided a report on the Shedden and Fingal Water and
 Wastewater service update, indicating that design work is underway and
 construction and access to wastewater servicing is anticipated in fall of 2025.
- b. Talbotville EA Addendum Completion & Next Steps
 Director VanOorspronk indicated that the first EA addendum is wrapping up and a
 subsequent EA to ensure an assimilative capacity study is completed to expand
 plant capacity to accommodate industrial growth is planned.
- c. Planning Department Personnel
 Christie Kent, the new Township planner was introduced to the committee.

5. Elgin County Updates

a. BR & E Status Update

Manager Krahn reported that 92 businesses were interviewed during the process with a wide range of industries being represented.

Some of the key themes that have come out these interviews are:

- Community development resources
- Business climate is positive in Elgin
- Challenges with development and building permit processes simple guide with development approvals processes requested
- Work force there were challenges noted in attracting and recruiting staff in the work force, especially noted in the manufacturing industry.
- Business resources; it was noted that many organizations welcomed the opportunity to network in the

Manager Krahn reported that the full report will be available shortly and will be circulated to the Committee once it is complete.

b. Elgin County Tourism Signage Program Update:

Manager Krahn provided an update on the Elgin County Tourism sign program and spoke to the various options that were available. A suggestion for a mapping app should be added to the department and incorporating digital wayfinding was discussed by the committee.

Investment Attraction Package
 Manager Krahn reviewed the Investment Attraction Package with the committee.

6. Southwold Business Networking Event Planning

Steve Bushell offered his property as a venue for the Networking event for Southwold and suggested that a Tuesday or Wednesday is the best option for his business.

Carolyn Krahn recommended that the events that she has typically attended include social discussions, entertainment, facilitated discussions, and a draw to bring the community together. It is really up to the Committee as to what is featured in the event.

Staff were tasked with brining a report back to the committee to discuss a possible event that featured information on:

- Elgincentives program, Elgin County programs available to new businesses; review of the Elgincentives program
- Southwold staff members to attend to answer questions
- Resources new tourism signs being launched
- Programs in the municipality, needs to be something new there needs to be a draw to bring people out to the event
- Purpose to bring people to the event; have a purpose, have a prize, have a draw to the event. Proposed suggestions of the committee included information on cybersecurity, digital marketing, land severances and farm succession planning.

Elgin County indicated that they would assist with this event.

7. Items for Sale Strategy

The sale of the first 4 signs was a success. Another sign will be auctioned off at the Canada Day Celebration.

8. Southwold's 175th Anniversary Planning – 2025

SUBJECT MATTER: Economic Development Committee - Rural Business

Networking Event

Recommendation(s):

That the Committee receive this report as information and provide feedback on the proposed agenda and format for an EDC sponsored rural business networking event.

Purpose:

This report provides an update to the Committee on plans for a Rural Business Networking Event.

Background:

Included in the 2020 Southwold Township Community Economic Development Plan, the Implementation Plan included "Establish a committee to host a special event" and "Host small business networking events".

During the 2024 Elgin County-Led Business Retention and Expansion program, many rural Southwold businesses cited a desire to have a "business after five" type event that was geared specifically for Southwold and rural businesses.

At the May and June meetings of the EDC, the Committee tasked staff with bringing a report back to the Committee to discuss a possible event that featured information on:

- Elgincentives program, Elgin County programs available to new businesses;
 review of the Elgincentives program
- Southwold & Elgin County staff members to attend to answer questions
- Resources new tourism signs being launched
- Programs in the municipality, needs to be something new there needs to be a draw to bring people out to the event
- Purpose to bring people to the event; have a purpose, have a prize, have a draw to the event. Proposed suggestions of the committee included information on cybersecurity, digital marketing, land severances and farm succession planning.

In the discussion at the EDC, there was discussion that the event could be a shared event with the Dutton Dunwich Economic Development Committee.

Comment:

Staff are recommending that the following be scheduled for the event:

- Hosted at Nature's Oasis on Second Line in Southwold
- The event could be helmed by Elgin County Economic Development (Carolyn Krahn/Abigail Moore) with support from a small committee of members from West Elgin EDC, DDEDC and Southwold EDC.
- To take place during the last two weeks of September date to be confirmed.
- An estimated total budget of \$2,500 could be allocated for the event (from Elgin County).
- Staff recommend a Catered Event would recommend a Southwold-based caterer, such as "Made with Love", "The Streetery", "Royal Oak" etc.
- Cash bar need to find someone to host this?
- Should there be Décor/Theme?
- Should there be entertainment (a band or similar) maybe even locally Cole
 Higgs, Nick Ewanick, or Connor Wilson just to play music during networking?
- Possible Agenda Items:
 - Commercial Downtown Redevelopment in Shedden, Fingal, and Talbotville (20 minutes)
 - Director of Infrastructure to present on investment coming to Fingal for streetscape improvements
 - Vision from business community what do they see for the future of downtown.
 - o Land Use in a Rural Municipality (20 minutes)
 - Local/County Planner to present on overview of planning hierarchy, land division in general, tips for a farm surplus severance, process for approvals, timelines.
 - Discuss on-farm diversified uses, agritourism, home industry, agribusiness – depending on progress of policy development, an opportunity for businesses to provide feedback on potential policies or to share draft updates to the Zoning By-Law to reflect new policy direction
 - o Thriving in the Digital Economy (30 minutes)

- Digital Marketing and Social Media –expert to speak (topics to include online sales options, advertising, using social media to business advantage, tips for social media clicks, building an effective website, etc.) Possible experts: Will Heeman, Angela DeVries
- Cybersecurity expert to speak to ways to improve cybersecurity for a business, insurance options for cybersecurity. Possible experts: markIT ((https://markit-techsolutions.com/)
- Live Auction/Draw for a Municipal Entrance Sign

Financial Implications:

Staff recommend a total budget of \$2,500, with funding provided by Elgin County Economic Development.
