1. Call to Order

Chair Scott Fellows called the meeting to order at 6:35 PM.

2. Approval of Agenda

4. Spring Walkthrough

Len Lynch and Councillor Sarah Emons were present to discuss the memorial forest area. Len provided a history on the implementation of the forest. Councillor Emons provided her expertise in biodiversity and encouraged the committee to consider having a qualified consultant complete a maintenance plan for the forested area.

The committee completed a walk-through of the grounds, including the complex, playground, pavilion, barn, horse ring, walking trail, and Corsley Park. Comments made during the walkthrough are noted in the Keystone Park and Ground Maintenance Concerns 2025 Spreadsheet attached.

5. Business Arising from Minutes

a. Electronic Sign

Staff advised that additional quotes are being obtained in line with our procurement policy. Staff will continue to provide updates via email as they become available.

b. Rosy Electrical Additions

Staff commented that Rosy Rhubarb representatives have been advised to contact Corey Pemberton, Director of Community Services/CBO, to discuss details. Keith Orchard from the

Rosy Rhubarb Committee has been informed to contact Corey.

c. Sunshade for Playground.

Staff are in support of Rosy Rhubarb representatives investigating the options for a sunshade and present to staff for consideration. Rosy Rhubarb has indicated this may be a possible

budget item for their organisation to vote on for 2026.

d. Playground Bench

Staff have inspected the bench at the playground and have determined that the bench needs to be sanded and repainted, however the structural components are intact. Rosy Rhubarb has

submitted an application for an additional bench at the playground.

6. New Business

a. Corsley Park Committee Representation Report

Councillor Fellows spoke on the report provided by the committee and by staff and the committee discussed thoughts about the recommendations. Shedden Soccer shared that with the challenge to obtain volunteers, removing them from the committee may result in lost volunteers, however they understood the logics behind the recommendations and supported

them.

Brian Rieger made the motion to include an additional recommendation when presenting to Council, that would provide for the same Council Representative and Township Representative appointed to both the newly revised Keystone Complex Committee and the Parks Committee.
